

Conditions of use Ashton Packet Boat Company (APBC) Ltd. SLIPWAY

1. Slipway must be booked prior to use, full details of vessel to be provided , the company cannot accept responsibility for any loss resulting from details not provided.
2. Slipping of vessels will normally be on a Saturday approximately midday, vessels must arrive in plenty of time prior for inspection to allow the task to be properly assessed.
3. No unauthorised personnel to be adjacent any machinery or apparatus during slipway operation children and animals in particular must be under the control of a responsible adult. The Client is fully responsible for their safety and behaviour at all times.
4. Once the vessel is secured, the slipway area will be cordoned off. The demarked area is then under the control of the Client.
5. The Client will be briefed of any pertinent hazards or operations to take place on the site which may affect him and must make any visitors aware of these. All persons working on site shall be fully conversant with the Companies Safety Guidance and Risk Assessments that are available to be viewed both at the Yard Office and the accommodation block. You will need to be aware of your route to the slipway and be alert to the inevitable changes in level and the possibility of others and vehicles in the vicinity of this route. If you are unsure of anything please ask.
6. The Client is to be responsible for properly assessing the activity to take place and put in place whatever precautions/equipment they deem necessary to carry out those activities in a manner safe to themselves and those outside the slipway area without causing any undue nuisance.
7. The Client is to properly supervise any visitors from the site entrance to the slipway and their activities thereafter. Neither they nor the occupier is authorised to enter or make use of any other facilities or equipment on the site without prior arrangement. Any Children shall be under the control of and Supervision of a responsible adult at all times.
8. The company does not provide any equipment for use on the slipway, all to be provided by the Client.
9. On completion of any operation or task waste material to be removed completely off site by the Client and disposed of accordingly. Area to be left in

an orderly manner, additional charges may be made if the slipway is left in an unsatisfactory state.

10. The company cannot accept any responsibility for activities within the area under the control of the Client, however the company reserves the right at all times to stop any activity and have removed from the site any equipment or persons which it considers is a hazard or nuisance to the occupier or any neighbours.
11. Vehicles shall be parked in the areas designated by the Ashton Packet Boat Co. normally adjacent the entry gates. Vehicles may load and unload adjacent to the slipway by arrangement. A speed limit of 5mph shall be maintained within the yard. The Company will accept no responsibility for any vehicle left on site. The sole responsibility will lie with the Client.
12. The Client must not interfere with any part of the Boat yard electrical system or associated equipment. Any faults should be reported to a manager.
